

Lesson 07. Consolidation and knowledge test readiness

OBJECTIVE

The candidate leaves phase 1 with the fundamentals of instruction as a working tool, and with a recorded readiness check saying whether they are ready to be recommended for the fundamentals of instructing knowledge test.

This is a consolidation lesson, not a cram session. If the candidate needs to be taught Area I content here, phase 1 did not work and the honest response is to say so rather than to compress six lessons into one hour.

LESSON STEPS: THE ELEMENTS, IN TEACHING ORDER

Check each element as it is taught. Leave anything not done blank. Sign once at the bottom.

- Area I in one pass: what each task is for and how they connect
FAA-S-ACS-25 Area I
- The knowledge test: which one, when, validity, and the exemption
policy/KNOWLEDGE-TESTS.md
- The 61.183(d) endorsement, and what the instructor is attesting to
61.183(d), 61.185(a)(1)
- The readiness check
program/FOI-TEST-READINESS.md
- A second regulation-or-policy sort, with different items from lesson 5
US-3.4
- Candidate teaches an Area I task chosen by the instructor at the start of the lesson
FI.I.E.S1
- Where phase 1 lands in phase 2: teaching a technical subject uses all of this
program/PROGRAM-STRUCTURE.md

COMPLETION STANDARDS

- The candidate teaches an Area I task assigned at the start of the lesson, without preparation time, to the standard of standards/CRITIQUE-STANDARD.md.
- The candidate connects two Area I tasks, explaining how something from one changes how they would teach the other.
- The candidate sorts the second regulation-or-policy list correctly, or looks up what they do not know rather than guessing.
- The candidate completes the readiness check in program/FOI-TEST-READINESS.md, and the result is recorded with the name of who ran it and the date.
- The candidate states which knowledge test comes next, when it is valid until, and whether the 61.183(e) exemption applies to them.
- The candidate delivers a self-critique before hearing the instructor's.

Standard 4 is completed, not passed. The check produces a result. A "not ready" result satisfies this standard.

DEBRIEF AND SIGN-OFF

Critique: the error, its probable cause, and the correction. Candidate self-critique first.

Sign once for the whole lesson. Elements left unchecked above were not taught this session.
