OBJECTIVE

The candidate can determine whether a pilot in front of them is legal to fly today, and can teach a student to determine it for themselves, working from the live regulation rather than from memory.

LESSON STEPS: THE ELEMENTS, IN TEACHING ORDER

Check each element as it is taught. Leave anything not done blank. Sign once at the bottom.

9. Candidate teaches an assigned element to the Simulated Student

COMPLETION STANDARDS

1. The candidate finds three assigned rules in live eCFR without help, and states the section number for each.
2. The candidate teaches an assigned element to the Simulated Student, sending them to a live source rather than asserting from memory.
3. The candidate determines what the returning pilot needs to be legal, correctly, and shows the regulation rather than asserting it.
4. The candidate distinguishes a regulation from an AIM entry, an advisory circular, and a handbook, and says what weight each carries.
5. The candidate identifies one North Aero policy in this subject area that is stricter than the regulation, and says which is which.
6. The candidate delivers a self-critique before hearing the instructor's.

DEBRIEF AND SIGN-OFF

Critique: the error, its probable cause, and the correction. Candidate self-critique first.

Sign once for the whole lesson. Elements left unchecked above were not taught this session.
